Parent Registration Form

The purpose of the Fresno Kodomo Center is to introduce Japanese culture and way of life: group harmony, conservation of resources, respect for elders, and cooperative effort to children of all ethnicities and religious denominations in a safe environment. This summer program will be led by Rev. Kaz Nakata, certified teachers, and volunteers.

We are currently accepting children aged 4-5 years old and toilet trained. Registration fees are \$300 per child, \$250/child if parent(s)/legal guardian(s) are members of any Central California Jodo Shinshu Buddhist Temple, or \$150/child if parent(s)/legal guardian(s) are members of the Fresno Betsuin Buddhist Temple. **Space is limited.** To insure your reservation, fees can be paid in full at the time of registration or paid in two installments: half at the time of registration with the balance due by May 5, 2023. Fees are nonrefundable because our supplies are purchased in advance, fingerprinting of teachers/adult volunteers, and possibly one field trip which is included in your registration fee.

During recess and snack time, children will be accompanied by an adult volunteer and are expected to stay within designated areas. We are asking your child to bring their own lunch daily to insure both Covid-19 and allergy safety. If your child prefers to drink something besides water, please send it with them. We will occasionally provide Japanese food and/or snacks, so please complete the Allergies and Medications form. Masks are optional but highly recommended (disposable child sized masks are preferred in case they get lost).

Parents are responsible for the conduct of their children at the Fresno Kodomo Center. If a child or family is unable to cooperate with the goals and objectives of the Fresno Kodomo Center or continues to disrupt the class or at recess, we will request a parent-staff meeting which may result in releasing the child from further participation without reimbursement.

Parent(s)/legal guardian(s) must sign the Fresno Kodomo Center's "Waiver of Liability". The Fresno Betsuin Buddhist Temple/Fresno Kodomo Center retains the copyright of all photographs taken by the Center which may be used for promotional, advertising, or other publicity purposes.

Sign In/Out Procedures: Your child must be signed in and out each day by the designated adult. Full, legible, legal signatures are required - not initials. Grandparents, Guardians, or Relatives should be included in the contact info if they will be signing in and/or checking out your child. Children may only be signed in or out by adults listed on their Registration form and Emergency and Release contact form. Anyone signing in or checking out your child must have a picture ID on file with our Registrar. Please bring current photos of your child, parent(s) and others assigned for drop off/pick up for your child's safety at our May orientation.

Guest Speakers often provide interactive experiences that will enhance a cultural journey. Families will be informed in advance about the guest and nature of their presentation. The presentations are provided at no extra cost.

Please give medication to your child at home prior to or after the program. We cannot administer medication to any child including over-the-counter items such as Tylenol, cough medicine, etc. If your child requires medication while at the Kodomo Center, we can set aside time for you or legal guardian(s) to come administer the medication as required. Please see the Waiver/Release of Liability form for more information.

Waiver and Release of Liability

Emergency Care: In case of an emergency involving an accident or possible illness, I grant permission to the Fresno Kodomo Center staff to arrange for medical, dental, and/or surgical care at the closest hospital. I understand every effort will be made to notify me before such action is taken and the uninsured expense of this service will be assumed by me. Regarding minor injuries, you will be called and the child will be given first aid attention by our on-call health professional if necessary.

Waiver/Release of Liability: On behalf of myself, my child(ren) enrolled, and my family, I acknowledge that certain activities my child(ren) may participate in carry the risk of injury. I do hereby waive, release and forever discharge the Fresno Kodomo Center and its team of coordinators and volunteers as well as the Fresno Betsuin Buddhist Temple.
