INFORMATION SHEET

CRITERIA:

1. The student must be of the Buddhist faith.
2. The student or parent must be a paid member of a temple or affiliated organization of the Buddhist Churches of America (BCA).
3. The student must have graduated from a college or university with an undergraduate degree.
4. The student is pursuing an advanced degree e.g., Ph.D., M.D., M.A., etc.

There are two scholarship categories:

1. **REGIONAL** ~ This scholarship is available to any student from the Fresno Betsuin or a member temple of the Central California District Council of the Buddhist Churches of America (CCDC-BCA): Fresno, Fowler, Hanford, Parlier, Reedley, Visalia, Dinuba, Delano
2. **NATIONAL** ~ This scholarship is available to any student living in the United States who is a member or whose parent(s) are members of an affiliate temple of the Buddhist Churches of America (BCA) other than any Central California temple (CCDC).

There will be one or more scholarships available. The minimum amount awarded will be \$1,000.

The student may apply for a scholarship from both categories, if applicable, but will receive only one scholarship award.

The student may apply for a scholarship each year.
